3.1 School Performance Plan - Principal Collins has submitted the plan. We will maintain the same goals as last year, as distance learning prevented us from realizing our goals:

- 1. Positive Attendance
- 2. Credit Sufficiency
- 3. 90 days sobriety proved with drug testing

3.2 Title 1 - We can hire a highly qualified tutor who can work with students individually to help them obtain credits through virtual learning. This individualized support will be a benefit to our students who are credit deficient.

3.3 Title 3 - We are still waiting for funds for the 21-22 school year; at that point, we will discuss what to do with them.

3.4 Hope 2 - We will not be able to use Hope 2 grant money for the 21-22 school year, but we will be able to apply for the grant the following school year. Waiting till the 22-23 school year is advantageous, as we will have a number of MHS graduates in a pool of candidates to choose from. Having a young MHS graduate who has “walked the walk” will be a tremendous resource to our future students.

Chelsea: It would be great to see a young MHS graduate also serving as a peer/recovery mentor at APG. High school students fighting addiction have very few places to go where they will find other teens pursuing recovery.
