3.3 Continuous Improvement Plan Updates

- Goal 1: Mission HS will continue to build social and emotional competencies to increase students’ academic growth and success through a multi-tiered system of support that focuses on academics, attendance, all facets of recovery, restorative practices and building strong support systems for the students.
- Goal 2: Mission High School will continue to provide learning tasks and opportunities for students to build self-advocacy skills. Through a scaffolded plan of teaching and learning, students will work with teachers and counseling staff to work through research based practices to build resiliency, goal setting, self- esteem, and advocacy skills.
- Goal 3: Mission High School will train their staff in trauma informed learning and social-emotional learning. MFT’s will continue to work with parents on providing groups to also understand the impact of trauma.
