3.2 Review Title I plan – Mission HS was afforded a budget of \$12035.00 for the 21-22 SY. This money was used to buy a Certified Temporary Tutor (CTT) to support the School Performance Plan priority goals one and three. The CTT will allow MHS to add physical education to our list of available classes. Adding physical education has shown to support recovery by reducing stress, promoting better sleep, improved mood, and increased energy to prevent relapse by creating a natural “high” through released endorphins. Goal 1 focuses on increase the number of students reaching 90 days of sobriety while Goal 3 focuses on increasing the percent of students who are credit sufficient.

The Title I plan can also be reviewed on our website and we will continue to meet regarding the 21-22 Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) until it is complete. After final approval, it will also be posted on the MHS website.

3.3 Review Title III plan – Mission HS will implement cross curricular targeted instruction with ELA and social students in all language domains (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) for all ELL students. A reader’s theater class was created for these students and non-fiction historical plays were chosen to meet the goals outlined in this plan.
